Needed some space inside.

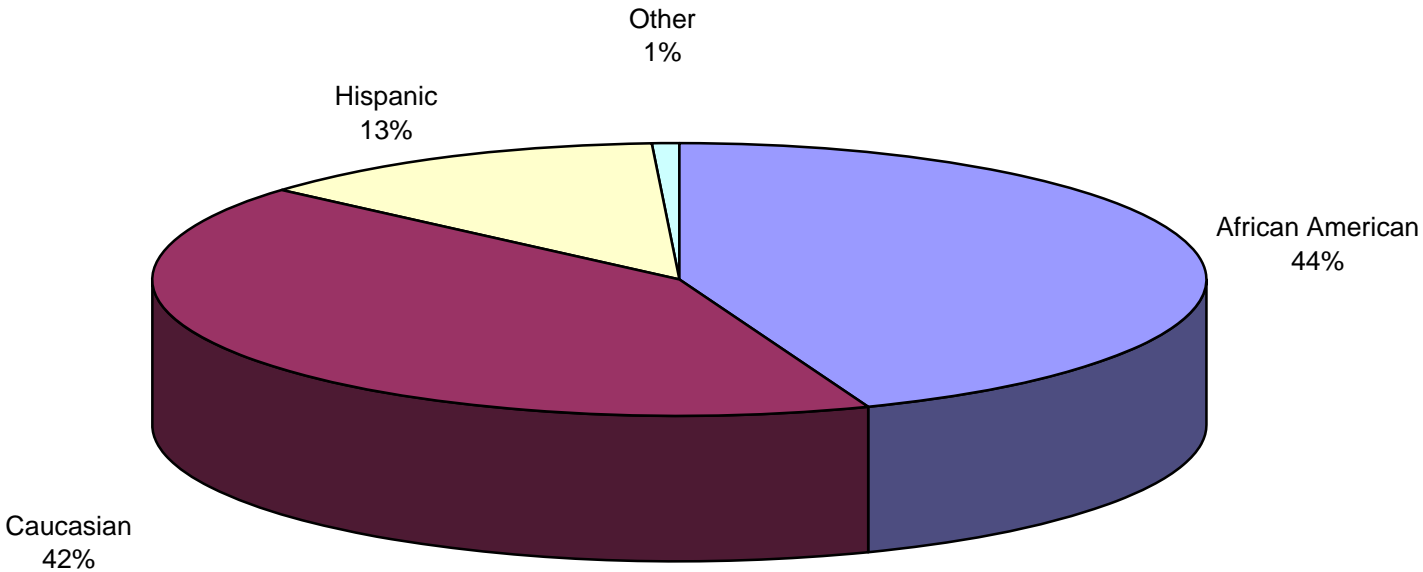

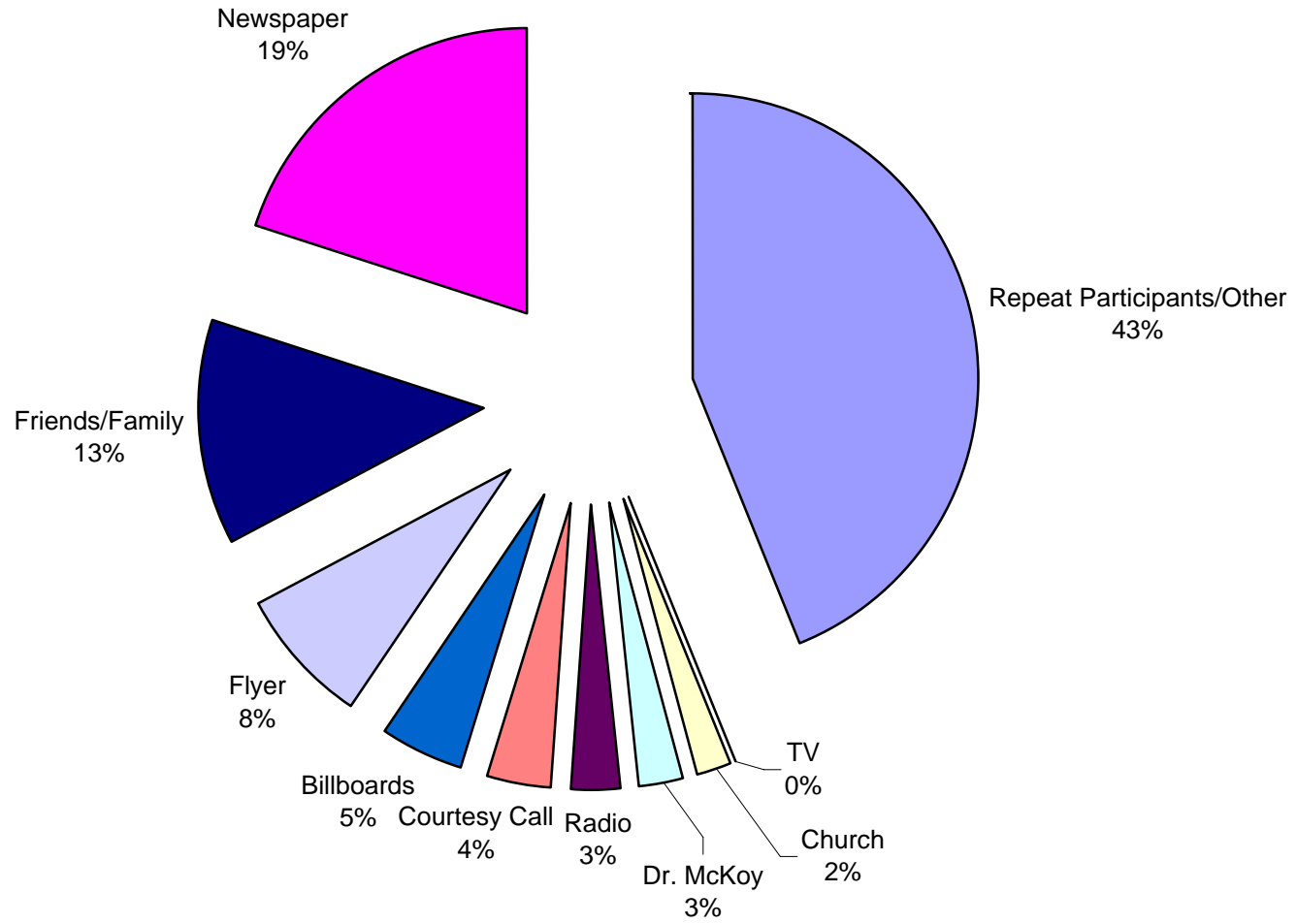

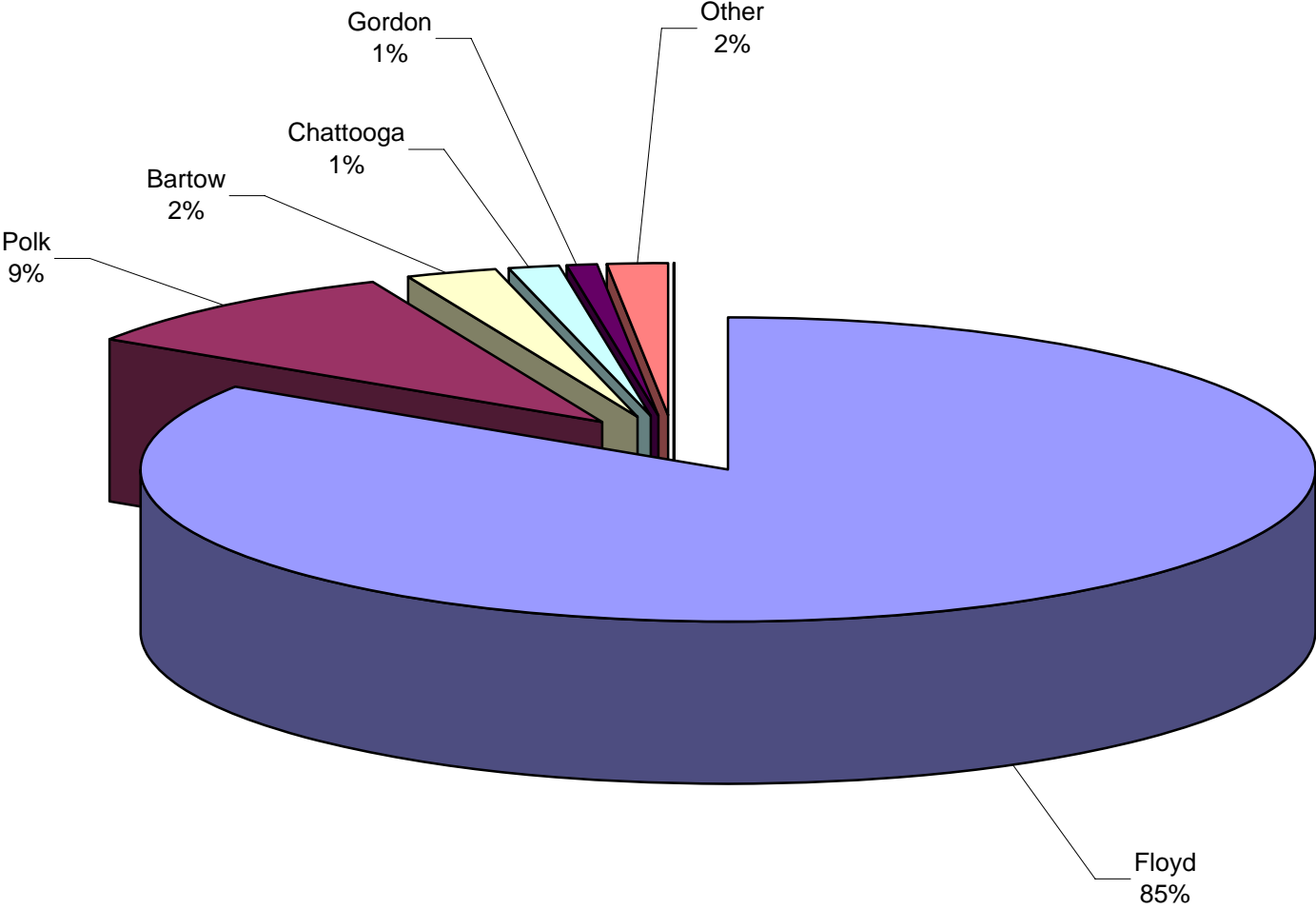
Ethnic Groups--2008 HIM Fair

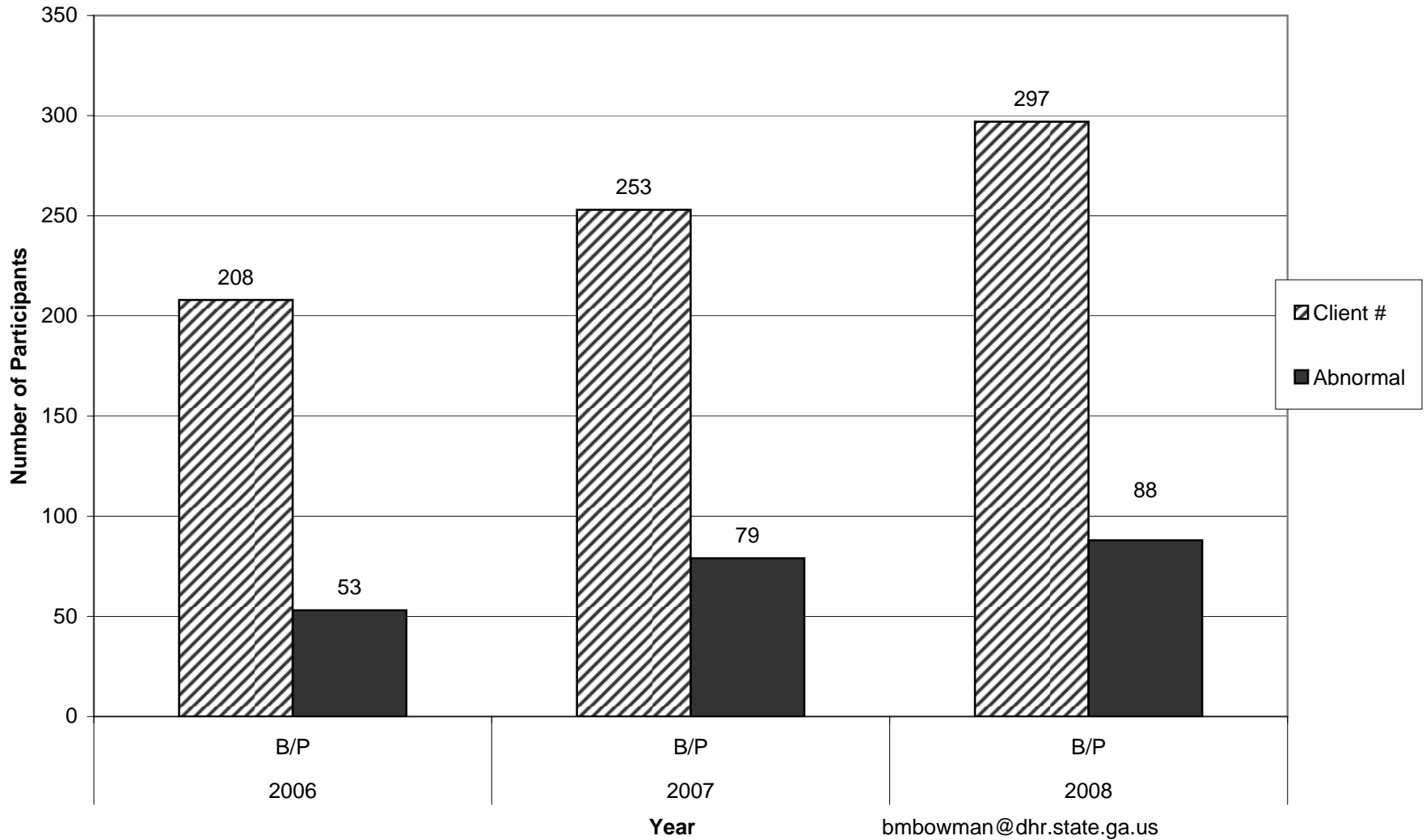


Counties Represented at 2008 HIM Fair

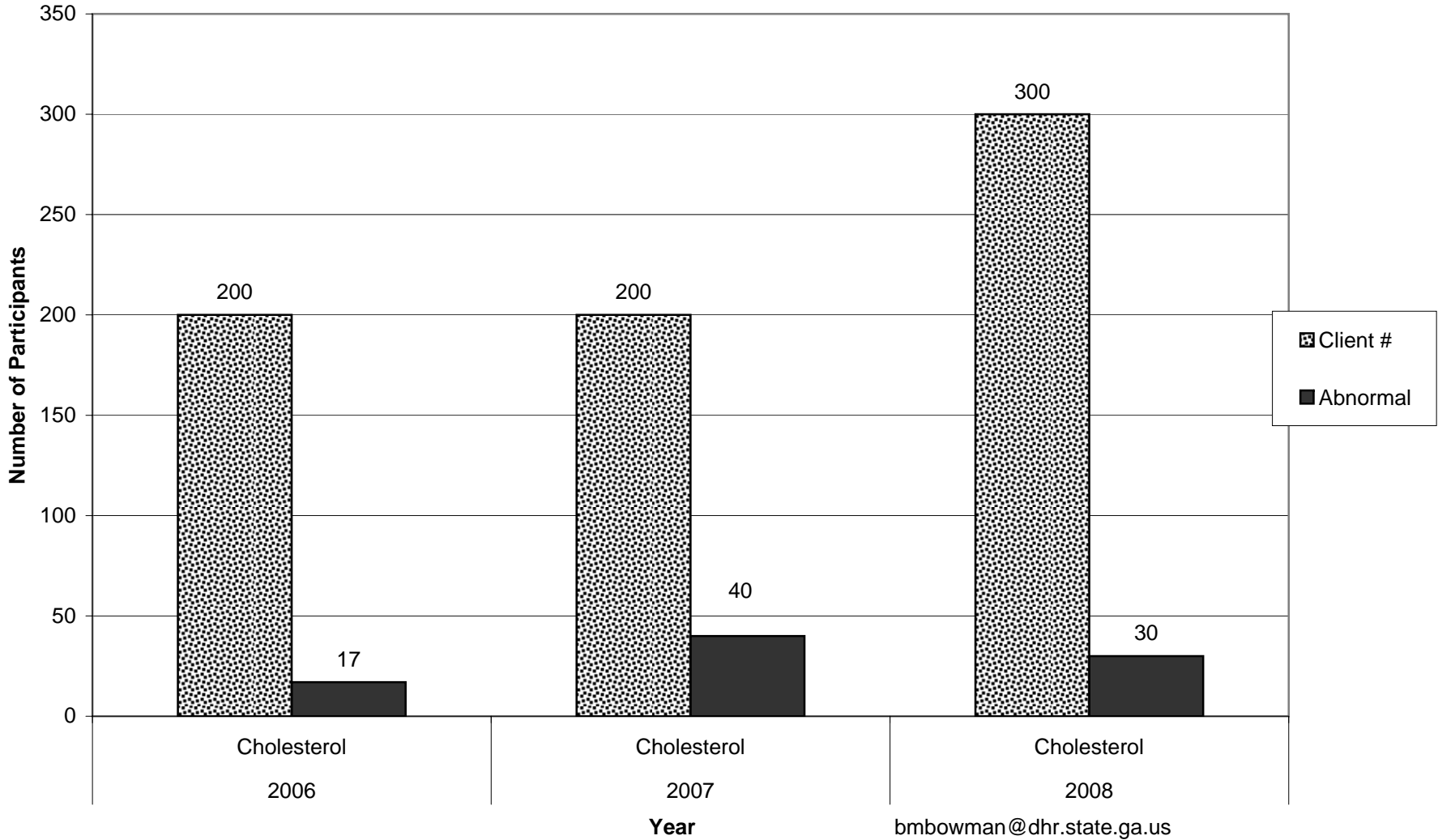

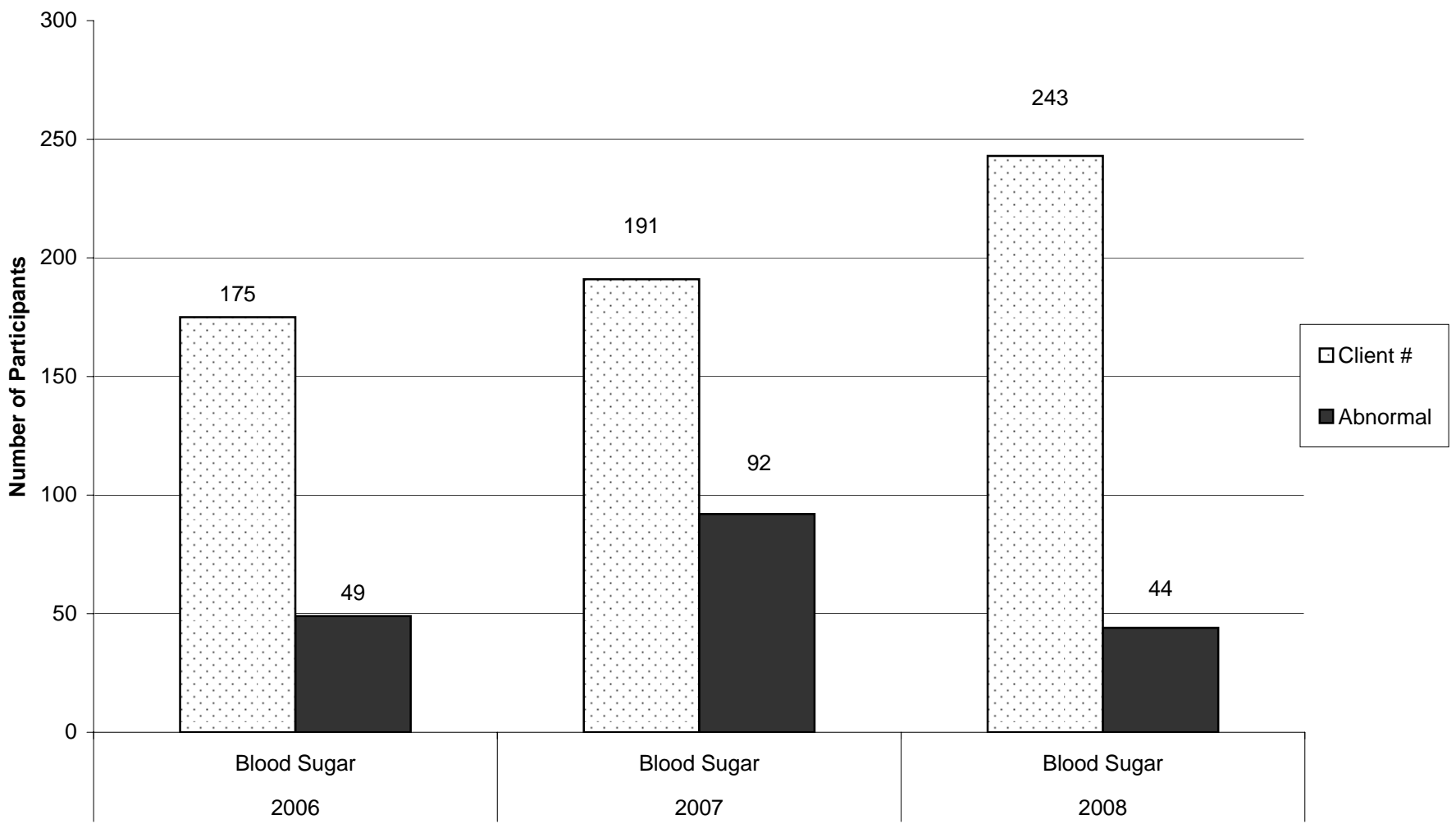
Health Initiative for Men--Floyd County 2008 Blood Pressure Screening



Health Initiative for Men--Floyd County 2008 Cholesterol Screening

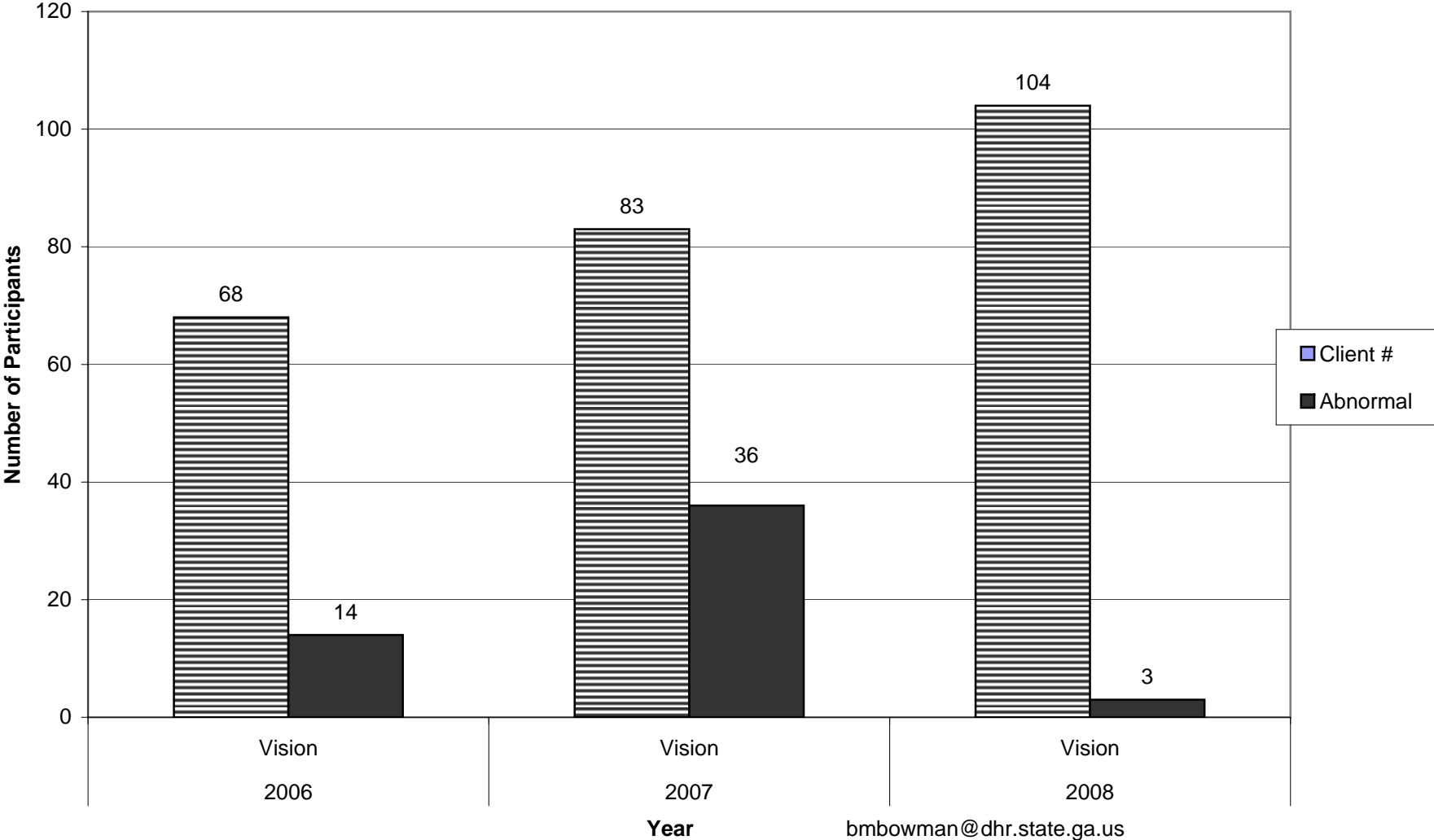


Health Initiative for Men--Floyd County 2008 Blood Sugar Screening

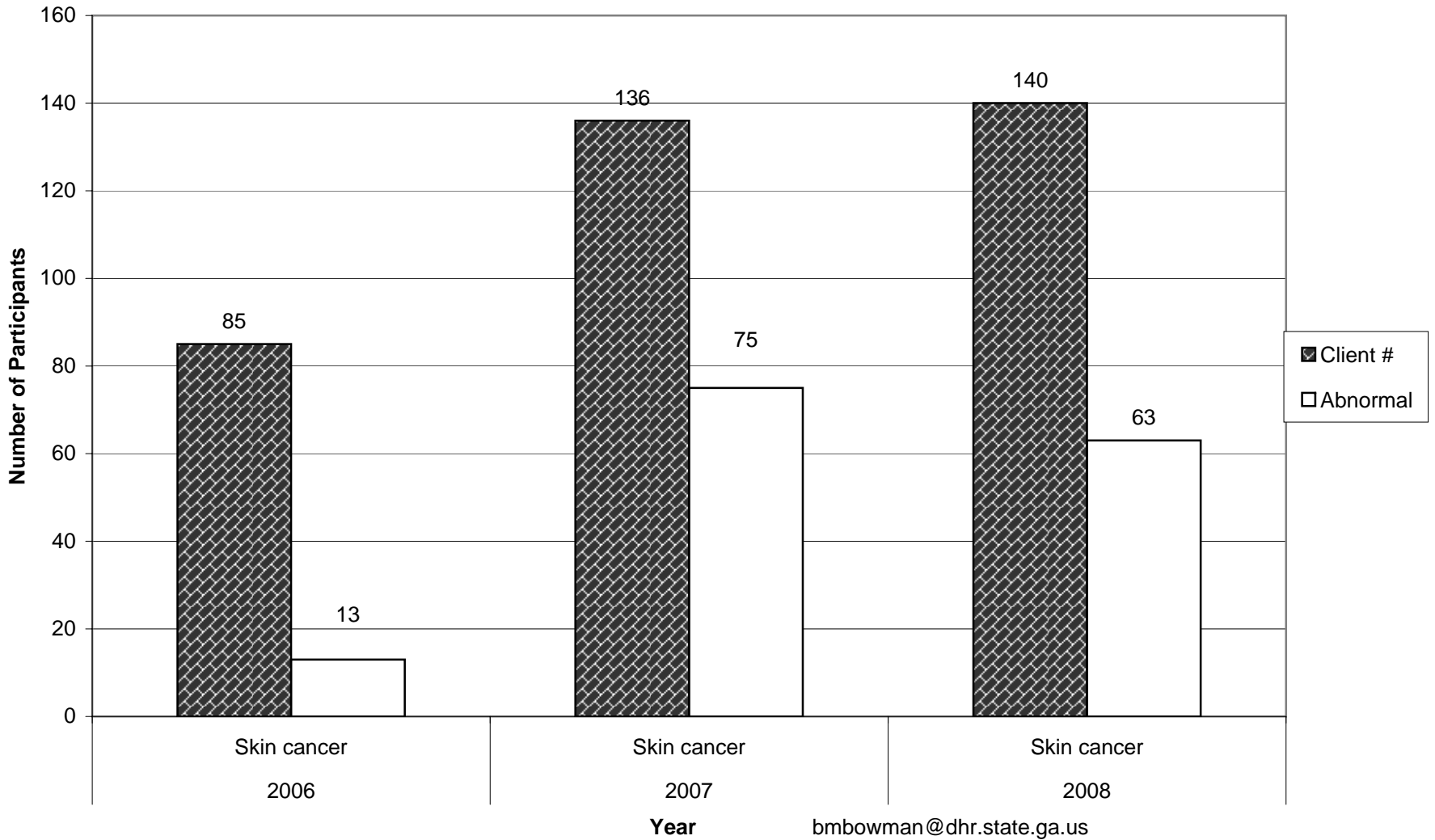

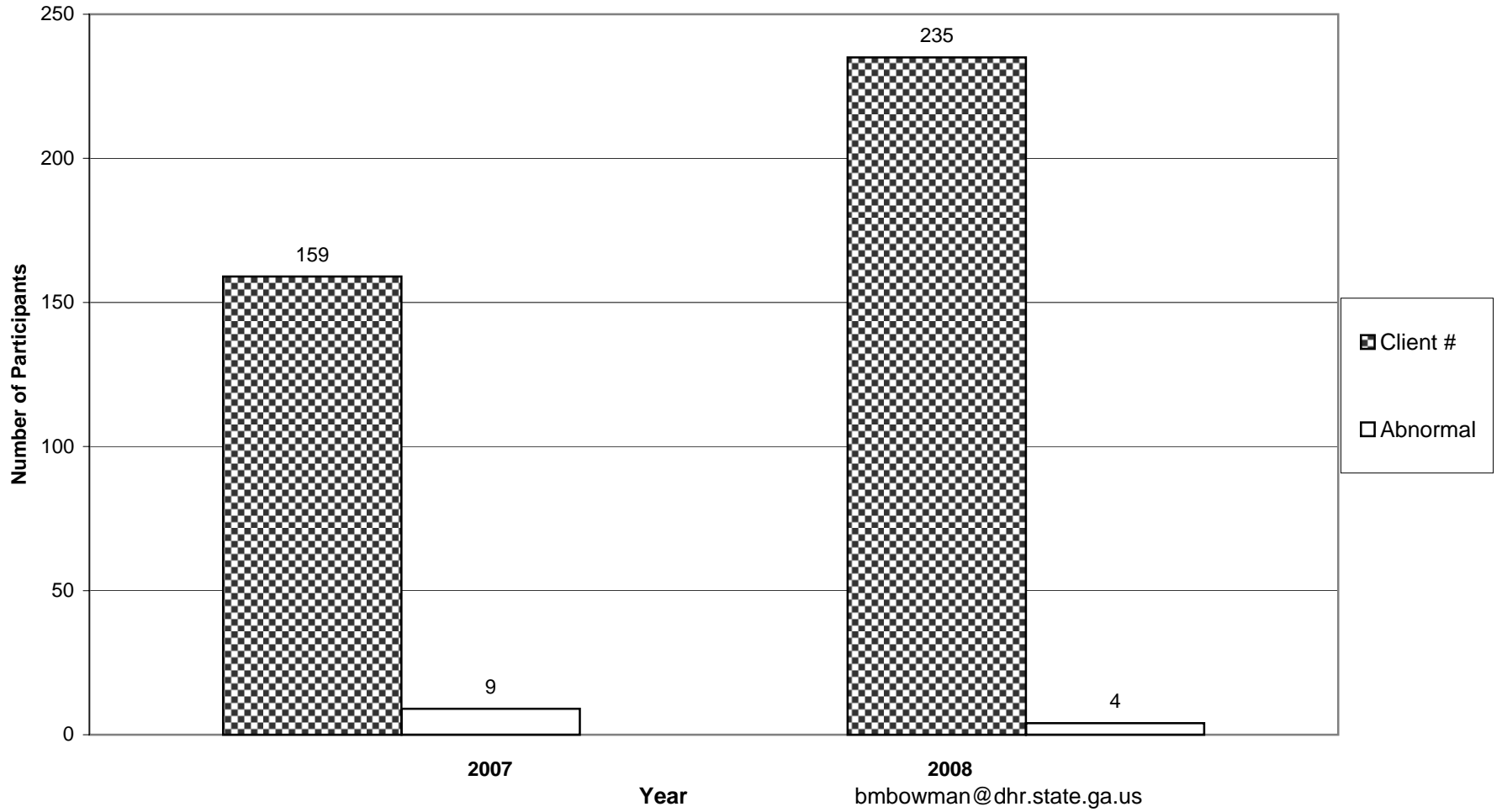
Health Initiative for Men--Floyd County 2008 Vision Screening
